DR. COLIN HARVEY, BVSc, FRCVS, Dip. ACVS, Dip. AVDC

Dr. Colin Harvey currently serves as Executive Secretary of the American Veterinary Dental College. He is currently Professor of Surgery and Dentistry at the School of Veterinary Medicine of the University of Pennsylvania in Philadelphia. Dr. Harvey is a board certified Diplomate of the American Veterinary Dental College and of the American College of Veterinary Surgeons, as well as a Fellow of the Royal College of Veterinary Surgeons.

Dr. Harvey has served as past President of the American Veterinary Dental College. Dr. Harvey lectures nationally and internationally, lecturing for the Department of Periodontics at the School of Veterinary Medicine of the University of Pennsylvania and the Faculties of Veterinary Sciences and Dental Surgery at the University of Liverpool.

He earned his BVSc degree from the University of Bristol Veterinary School in 1966, then completed his residency in Small Animal Surgery at the Veterinary Hospital of the University of Pennsylvania. There he later served as Chief of the Section of Small Animal Surgery from 1974 to 1980, as well as Vice-Chair of the Department of Clinical Studies from 1996 to 2002.

Dr. Harvey has been honored with the Norden Distinguished Teach Award from the University of Pennsylvania, as well as the Golden Scaler Award from the American Veterinary Dental College, among many other awards.

Dr. Harvey is the author of "Veterinary Dentistry" (WB Saunders Co, 1985) and Feline Dentistry (WB Saunders Co, 1992), and with Dr. Emily, co-authored "Small Animal Dentistry" (CV Mosby, 1993).
